LLANNERCHYMEDD COMMUNITY COUNCIL ANNUAL REPORT 2024-25

Chairman's introduction September 2024 - August 2025

Council membership - no changes. Some have been unwell during the period but thankfully everyone is recovering well.

2024

September

- snooker tables removed and the room transferred to the Education Department
- Alaw Môn / Maen Hir solar farms. Llan CC has presented strong opposition to the size of the developments.
- Request to move Eliseg back to Llangollen Railway

October

- Presentation by Môn Actif on developing play areas for children
- Sponsored 2 competitions to support the 2026 National Urdd Eisteddfod Anglesey
- Meetings held on solar panel projects
- Caru Llan – supported the good work of the group to establish play areas
- Progressed options to sell the Tan y Foel plot of land

November

- Painted the railings at the Memorial Field monument
- Arranged a poignant Remembrance Day service - thanks to everyone for the hard work.
- Major repairs to equipment in Caffi Stesion
- Agree on new gates to the Public Cemetery
- Problem with water supply in Carmel.

December - no meeting held, but daily tasks undertaken by the Clerk communicating with members as required.



2025

January

- Setting the IACC Precept following consideration of the 2025-26 cost forecasts - unanimously agreeing to raise 10% (as previously agreed over recent years) to meet continuous increases in costs of maintaining the village's resources
- Proposal by IACC to transfer the public Cemetery to the ownership of Llan CC for a nominal sum of £1. Matter currently in the hands of Llan CC Solicitors.

February

- Correspondence from the Anglesey Central Railway Company was discussed
- Work progressing to repair the Village Clock
- Contact the IACC again to report illegally parked cars throughout the village
- Inquiries about the ownership of the Public Cemetery
- First steps to ensure a better CCTV system in the Stations as a result of ongoing vandalism

March

- Meeting with Dŵr Cymru to discuss the concerning situation in Carmel
- Agree to repair a wall near the Jerusalem car park in order to ensure safety.
- Report of sheds at the back of the flats near the Bull - dogs barking continuously and their owners have left the flat
- Create a Zero Tolerance policy after a family member of one of the Councilors had experienced threatening behavior from a local resident. .

April

- Transfer control of the Allotments back to the Community Council.
- Substantial maintenance work to be done at Bowling Green - currently gathering quotations for costs
- Electricity bill from Scottish Power in regards of the Llan Football Club in dispute - official complaint in hand
- Memorial Fields – several complaints received about dog fouling not being picked up by owners.

May

- Excellent work undertaken to establish a junior children's cycle track near the in Memorial Field - thanks to the volunteers Caru Llan group
- Complaint received from Carmel about containers placed on property that obstruct visibility for other residents – acceptable resolution with IoACC ongoing.



June

- Eliseg has been moved.
- Sought guidance on administering and maintaining the neighborhoods defibrillators.
- Accounts 2023-24 approved by Audit Wales
- 2024-25 accounts in the hands of Audit Wales and presented within the given timescale.

July

- Agreed to investigate the establishment of a Finance Officer post
- Information received from Glan Menai surgery as to reduction in opening hours due to staff shortages, this being a temporary measure.
- Allotments have now been transferred - need to agree management and administration
- It was agreed that Llan CC arrange to clear Cae Gofeb's old play equipment to prepare for Part 2 of the Caru Llan project

August - no meeting held, but daily tasks undertaken by the Clerk communicating with members as required.

Throughout the period there were discussions and a site visit with the IoACC Highways Department to highlight Llan CC concerns regarding speeding; illegal parking; abandoned vehicles and the condition of the roads and in particular the bends near the Vicarage where there have been several accidents over the period.

FINANCE

- Financial support given to Yr Arwydd; Llan Golf; CPD Notice Board during the period.
- Cllr. JAJ has worked on another supplier for electricity – provider is now now British Gas. This follows ongoing customer service problems for the Clerk with Scottish Power. Significant money saving for Llan CC
- An increase of 8.5% in the IACC budget
- Members receive a monthly report on the financial situation - the minutes reflect the situation.
